From the desk of Fr. Richard Kennedy, MSC, Provincial Superior of the American Province of the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart

As I write this, the coronavirus seems to be getting worse throughout the U.S., Canada, and the rest of the world. So even though I would like to visit the MSC's ministering in the Ogdensburg Diocese, the San Bernardino, California Diocese, the Allentown Pennsylvania Diocese, and our men in Colombia, South America, I don't see myself boarding a plane to travel in the near future.

But we MSC's continue our ministries in innovative as well as traditional ways to bring hope and moral strength to those people who look to us for inspiration.

I share with you what some of our men have told me. Fr. Simi Volavola, MSC, from Fiji, is finishing his first semester's work at Mundelein Seminary in Chicago. He'll be residing at our retirement community at Center Valley, Pa., through the Christmas holidays and holydays. Fr. Corneille Boyeye, MSC, from the Congo is still limited to two days a week ministry at St. Lawrence Psychiatric Hospital in Ogdensburg. There are still limitations on his ministry at Watertown Samaritan Hospital. But he is able to assist Fr. Demo with weekend Masses in Watertown. Fr. Adrian Budhi, MSC, hospital chaplain from the Philippines residing at our parish in Riverside, Cal., is recovering from recent surgery. Fr. Michael Miller, MSC, secretary at our General House in Rome, Italy, writes that COVID restrictions are again in place in Rome. Two MSC's on the general staff tested positive to the coronavirus, but they are now back to good health. Fr. Bernie Jakubco, MSC, retired in Florida, writes that he is still COVID free and is still able to celebrate Mass in the parish where he resides. Br. Warren Perrotto, MSC, reports from Fiji that travels are restricted there because of the COVID virus. The seminarians there are doing most of their studies on line. Fr. Hugo Lodoño, MSC, superior of our Colombian community, reports that we have presently eight college seminarians. They are studying by remote learning. Fr. Hugo, his assistant priest and our two theology students are presently staffing our parish in Cuidad Kennedy. But the pandemic continues to cause serious problems in Bogota and in Colombia.

Keep us all in your prayers. We pray for you. Our Lady of the Sacred Heart, pray for us!


