Providing scholarships to individuals studying to be Missionaries of the Sacred Heart priests and brothers.

## Foundation Awards 74 Scholarships

The Sacred Heart Foundation Board of Directors approved \$77,000 in scholarship awards for 2014 at its March Board meeting. The Scholarship Committee reviewed applications from twelve different MSC Provinces in ten countries. Seventy-four MSC priests, deacons and seminary students will receive financial assistance. This is the highest annual award total since the scholarship program began in 1968.

### SACRED HEART FOUNDATION ASSOCIATES PROGRAM

The rising cost of education for those wishing to become Missionaries of the Sacred Heart has always been an issue of serious concern. For many young men, funds to finance their education are just not available from their family.

Father Pierre Aubin, MSC and a group of community leaders from Northern New York recognized the impact scholarship support could have on vocations world-wide. In June of 1967 they founded the Sacred Heart Foundation in Watertown, New York as a Tax-Exempt Corporation whose purpose was then, and is today, to fund those scholarships.

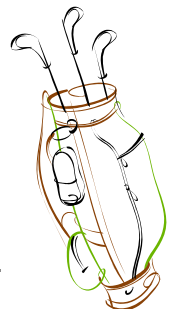

## Fr. Natale, MSC, Recipient of Foundation Scholarship support, speaker at 2014 Annual Dinner

Father Frank Natale, MSC, will be the featured speaker at the 41st Annual Benefit Dinner of the Sacred Heart Foundation.

The Foundation's Annual Dinner will again be held at the Hilton Garden Inn. This year's event is Wednesday, September 17, 2014 at 6 pm. The Foundation's Annual Membership Meeting will precede the dinner. Tickets will be available in mid-August and can be purchased from any Board or Honorary Council Member or by calling the Foundation office at 782-3344. Tickets sold out last year, and the Foundation expects a large crowd because this year is the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the founding of the MSC Province in the United States. Anyone wishing to attend should purchase their tickets early.

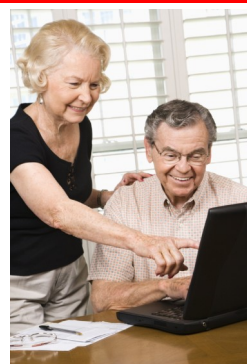
The Foundation is particularly pleased to bring Father Natale to Watertown as our featured speaker. The Foundation supported Father Natale for many years with scholarship assistance while he trained for the priesthood, and we have followed his progress with pride.

Father Natale was born and brought up in Canton, Ohio. He began thinking of service to the Church while in high school but initially attended a local technical school. He began his training to become a priest at Our Lady of the Lake University in San Antonio, Texas and graduated in 2006 with a degree in philosophy. He spent a year in spiritual formation with the MSC community in Australia and made his first profession of vows in December 2007. He professed his life-long vows as a member of the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart in 2011 at his hometown parish in Canton. In preparation for his ordination to the priesthood, Father Natale earned a Masters of Divinity degree from Catholic Theological Union in 2012. He was ordained a deacon in August 2012. and was ordained to the priesthood on June 29, 2013, in St. Joseph Church by the Most Rev. George V. Murray, SJ, Bishop of the Youngstown Diocese.

He has served as a deacon in Ottsville, PA and as a priest at Our Lady of Solitude in Palm Springs, CA.

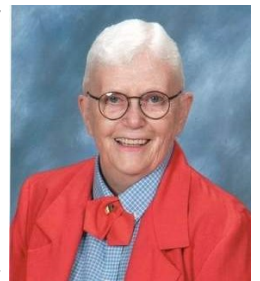

### Program Categories

The invested assets of the Foundation have grown over nearly five decades through donations large and small from our donors and from careful management of these donations. Foundation assets now exceed \$2.5 million. The Foundation Board takes its fiduciary responsibility very seriously and is very protective of these assets ensuring the Foundation can provide scholarships for years to come.

To recognize the extraordinary generosity of supporters of the Sacred Heart Foundation, the Directors established an Associates Program which consists of seven categories of donors.

The top category is the Scholarship Society. Its members have donated \$15,000 or more to the Foundation. In recognition of this donation level, scholarships awarded each year are identified with the donor's name or the name of a loved one as indicated by the donor.

This year two new members have been added to the "Scholarship Society." Dorothy Farrell included the Foundation in her will and the Foundation received a generous contribution. A second individual who opts to remain anonymous at this time has also reached the "Scholarship Society" level. In 2014, forty-three named scholarships will be awarded.

Each year in the Annual Dinner booklet, the Foundation lists the names of all donors in the Associates Program according to cumulative donation levels since June 1967. This year the Category level also appears on your new membership cards.
