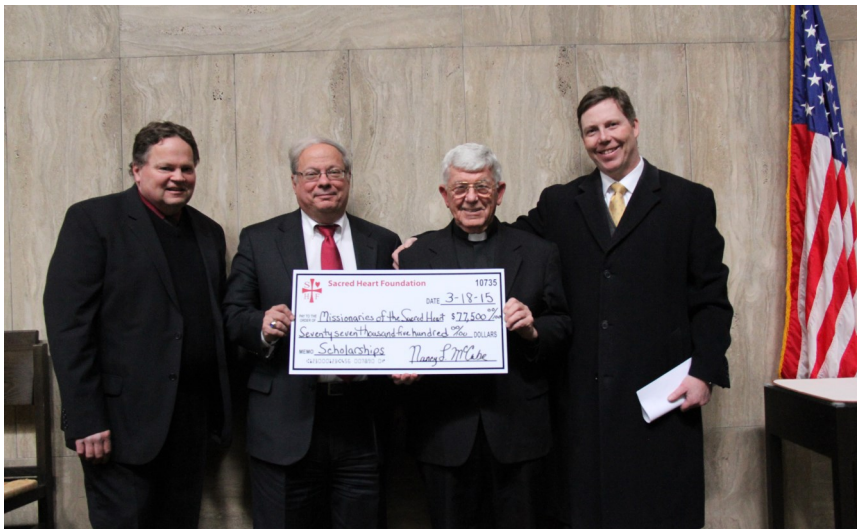

This Year the Sacred Heart Foundation Board of Directors is pleased to announce that \$77,500 in scholarship awards for 2015 was approved at the March Board Meeting. The Scholarship Committee reviewed applications from twelve different MSC Provinces located in Ten different countries. Eighty-four MSC deacons and seminary students will receive financial assistance. Through the generosity of our supporters since 1968 this is the highest annual award the Sacred Heart Foundation has given in scholarships.

Fr. Natale, MSC, Recipient of Foundation Scholarship support, speaker at 2015 Annual Dinner

Due to an injury last year Fr. Frank Natale was unable to fulfill the request to be the guest speaker at the Annual Benefit Dinner. We are pleased to announce that this year Father Frank Natale, MSC, will be the featured speaker at the 42nd Annual Benefit Dinner of the Sacred Heart Foundation.

The Foundation's Annual Dinner will again be held at the Hilton Garden Inn. This year's event is Wednesday, September 16, 2015 at 6 pm. The Foundation's Annual Membership Meeting will precede the dinner. Anyone wishing to attend should purchase their tickets early.

The Foundation is particularly pleased to bring Father Natale to Watertown as our featured speaker. The Foundation supported Father Natale for many years with scholarship assistance while he trained for the priesthood, and we have followed his progress with pride.

Father Natale was born and brought up in Canton, Ohio. He began thinking of service to the Church while in high school but initially attended a local technical school. He began his training to become a priest at Our Lady of the Lake University in San Antonio, Texas and graduated in 2006 with a degree in philosophy. He spent a year in spiritual formation with the MSC community in Australia and made his first profession of vows in December 2007. He professed his life-long vows as a member of the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart in 2011 at his hometown parish in Canton. In preparation for his ordination to the priesthood, Father Natale earned a Masters of Divinity degree from Catholic Theological Union in 2012. He was ordained a deacon in August 2012. and was ordained to the priesthood on June 29, 2013, in St. Joseph Church by the Most Rev. George V. Murray, SJ, Bishop of the Youngstown Diocese.

He has served as a deacon in Ottsville, PA and as a priest at Our Lady of Solitude in Palm Springs, CA.
