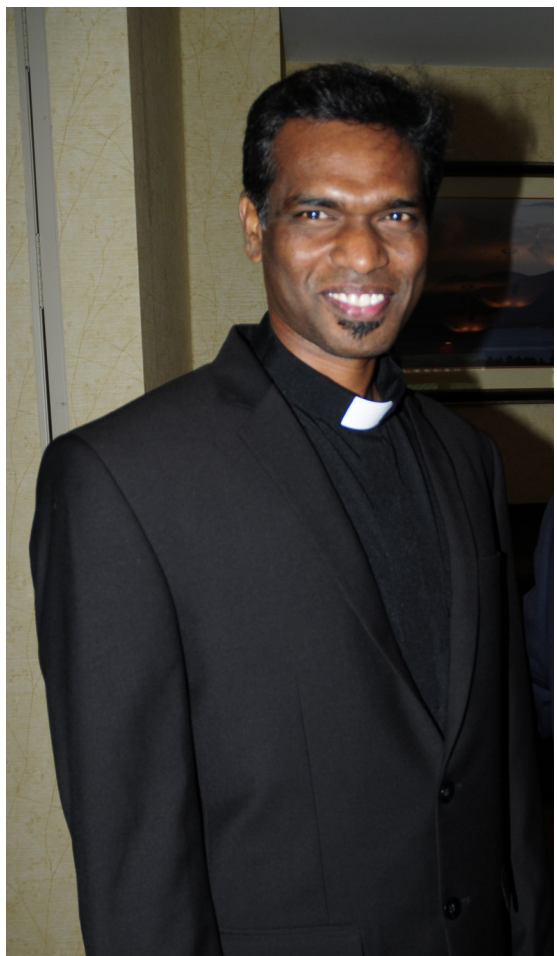

Fr. Christy arrived in Watertown in the spring of 2014. We greeted him with snow. That's when we learned that Father has a permanent, ever-present smile. His two year "tour-of-duty" has been filled with new experiences for him and joy for all who have been touched by his gentle presence.

Father has served as Parochial Vicar for St. Patrick's and St. Anthony's parishes in Watertown since his arrival. His duties included sharing the Mass schedule, celebrating weekday and weekend Masses at both parishes with Father Donald A. Robinson, Pastor when he arrived and subsequently Monsignor Robert H. Aucoin, the current Pastor of the parishes.

He preached in a rotation with the Pastor and the deacons of the parishes, and regularly took his turn in the confessional. Father also took on a ministry of visiting the sick of the parishes and presided each week at Mass at Samaritan-Keep Home, a 243-resident nursing home affiliated with the Samaritan Medical Center.

### ***Planned Giving***

The Sacred Heart Foundation has been blessed with many, many faithful friends who support it in one or more ways each and every year. Some contribute to Living Memorials, some participate in the Annual Golf Tournament, some attend the Annual Dinner and some send periodic contributions to the Foundation. Some friends do all of these. However you support the foundation, we are extremely grateful. - Naming the Foundation as one of the beneficiaries of your IRA or retirement plan
- Naming the Foundation as one of the beneficiaries of a life insurance policy.
